Dear Parents,

As part of our context for learning this term we have planned an exciting trip for Classes 1 and 2, and Thursday nursery children to visit the Lake District Wildlife Park near Keswick. This will give all the children a hands-on opportunity to find out more about their study of animals (Class 2) and local area (Class 1) as well as having lots of fun! The children in Class 2 will also take part in a workshop on animal classification which will be run by staff at the park.

The trip will take place during the school day on Thursday 9th May. We will leave school at 9.00am and return by 3.30pm. Children should wear their school polos and sweatshirts but can wear joggers or jeans and sturdy trainers or walking boots. Children must have a warm waterproof coat as the park is on quite an open and exposed site and may be cold and wet despite the time of year.
