Consolidation and assessment

<p>In the last two weeks of term, we would normally carry out assessments and work on consolidating our learning.</p> <p>I have uploaded some booklets covering key areas of number and calculations. (Some of you may have done some of these or parts of these early in lockdown, or when you had free access to Twinkl, in which case you can disregard!) You can do all of them or you could focus on an area where you think you need more practice. Alternatively, you could do bits and pieces from each. Just do a page or two each day. I will leave the choice up to you and one of the adults in your house. If you would like advice from me, please send me an email!</p>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Year 2 Number and place value booklet – this will help you practise partitioning, tens and ones, ordering and comparing numbers and so on.2. Year 2 Addition and subtraction booklet – this will help you practise adding and subtracting 1-digit and 2-digit numbers, use addition and subtraction to solve word problems and get some more practice at those demon missing number additions and subtractions!3. Year 2 Multiplication and division booklet – this will help you revise your times tables, write multiplication and division statements, solve problems, puzzles and challenges involving multiplication and division.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Year 3 Number and place value booklet – this will give you lots of practice at ordering and comparing numbers, partitioning into hundreds, tens and ones and so on.2. Year 3 addition and subtraction workbook – this gives lots of practice at adding and subtracting 2-digit and 3-digit numbers. If we had been at school, I would have been extending your understanding of column addition and subtraction where bridging is required, (carrying or exchanging to mums and dads). Don't panic – we will quickly learn this at the start of year 4! So, please miss out pages 8, 10, 12, 14, 21 and 22.3. Year 3 Multiplication and division booklet – this will help you revise your times tables and practise your quick mental recall of multiplication and division facts, as well as practise the new grid method of multiplication which you learnt at home earlier this term. There is also a section on bus stop division – we have not learnt this, but will do so in year 4, so I would suggest that you leave those pages out. <p>Mums and Dads - I have uploaded the answer booklets for the addition and subtraction and multiplication and division booklets so that you can see the methods taught.</p>
