We are delighted to say that, as it stands, our school Harvest Service will go ahead on Wednesday 6th October at 2.30pm in St. Kentigern's Church. Due to the ongoing safety measures in place we would like to invite **one adult per family** to attend the church service.

All children will take part in the Harvest Service and each class will deliver a short presentation on the harvest theme. On the day we would be grateful if each child could bring in a small harvest gift. We would request that these are non-perishable items such as tins, jars, tea, coffee or even something extra special like chocolates, biscuits or other treats. Due to restrictions we cannot accept homemade or unwrapped items I'm afraid.

These gifts will then be used to create mini hampers, which are then distributed to the retired residents of the village in a socially distanced and safe way.

The children in Years 5 and 6 will give out these hampers on Thursday 7th October. We know that these hampers are very much appreciated. Not only are the gifts very well received, but, provide the school children with a real opportunity to make valuable connections with their local community. We will need parents of children in Years 5 and 6 to give permission for their child/ren to be involved with distributing the gifts so if you have a child/ren in Years 5 or 6 please complete and return the slip at the bottom of this letter to confirm permission is granted.
